
## **Gambling in NSW**

We surveyed over 10,000 people from across NSW about gambling. This was the first study of its kind in NSW since 2011.



Some forms of gambling are more popular with certain demographic groups:



Lottery tickets are most popular with people aged 45-64 (46%)



Race betting is most common with people aged 45-54 (16%)



Young people aged 18-24 are the most likely to bet on sports (11%)



Gaming machines are most popular with people aged 18-24 (25%)

People who speak languages other than English at home had lower participation across the more common forms of gambling, with an overall gambling participation rate of 36%.



The NSW Government, through the Office of Responsible Gambling (the Office), develops and implements programs and initiatives that support responsible gambling and prevent and minimise the risk of gambling related harm in the community. The NSW Gambling Survey 2019 was funded through the Responsible Gambling Fund, and will inform the work of the Office.
