



How gambling in NSW is changing

We surveyed over 10,000 people from across NSW about gambling. This was the first study of its kind in NSW since 2011.



From 2011 to 2019, the proportion of the population who were:

- **Low-risk gamblers*** decreased from 8.4% to 6.6%
- **Moderate-risk gamblers*** remained stable at 2.8%**
- **Problem gamblers*** remained stable at 1%**
